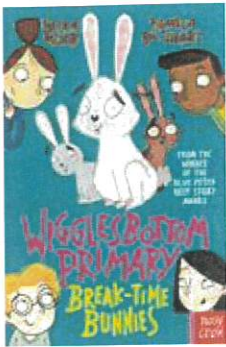


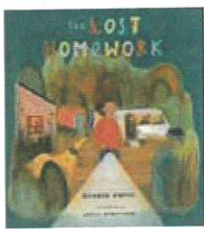

The Lost Homework

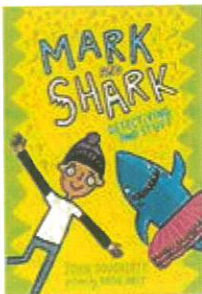
