

## Argh! There's a Skeleton Inside You!

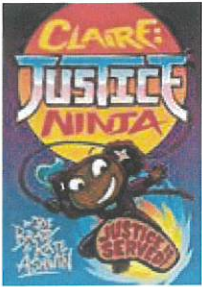

## Claire: Justice Ninja

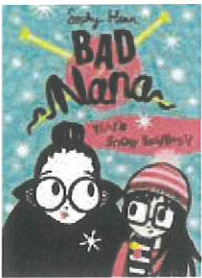
