Dear Parents/Carers,


Welcome back! We hope you have had a lovely summer break and managed to spend some quality time with your families. This letter provides some key information about this half term in Year 4.

We will be looking at a poem and 3 core texts in our English Lessons this half term. These will provide a stimulus for our writing.



Maths:

In Maths, we will be starting the year by understanding the place value of numbers up to and beyond 1000. We will then move on to looking at the mental and written fluency of addition and subtraction. We will also have a weekly focus on times tables. By the end of year 4, children are expected to be fluent with times tables up to 12 x 12.





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Theme:

Our theme for this half term will be **Freedom and Protection.** The entry point will be our school trip to London Zoo which will allow the children to begin to consider how animals are kept safe, their protection status, as well as potential threats on particular species. The children will use all the knowledge they gain over the unit to create a podcast about how to protect the habitat of a particular endangered animal.
