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
Year 4 Curriculum- Autumn 2

English:


We will be looking at two core texts in our English lessons this half term. These will provide a stimulus for our writing.

Maths:

In Maths, we will continue to develop children's confidence with calculating using addition and subtraction of numbers up to 4 digits. We will then look at the topic of measurement, as well as equivalent lengths in mm, cm, m and km and calculating area. Finally, we will teach multiplication strategies, starting with 3, 6, 9 and then 11 and 12 times tables.

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Theme:

Our theme for this half term will be **Compassion vs Cruelty.** The children will develop a wider understanding of these words through debate and role play, finding evidence within our key texts and in historical study of the Mayan civilization.












